PAINTING/ DRAWING COMPETITION SATURDAY 10th MAY 2025 – Witham's Cemetery

Please make sure you familiarise yourselves with the rules of this year's competition.

RULES OF ENTRY

- All entries must feature an element of Witham's Cemetery. The painting(s) must be either a view
 of, or feature an element of the cemetery, which may include the historic graves, the greenery or
 the cottage and must be completed between 09:00am 5:00pm on the 10th of May.
- **2.** Paintings/Drawings may be carried out using different traditional artistic media. We will not accept any digital entries.
- **3.** Participants must supply their own art materials which must be sensitive to the site, e.g., spray paint could leave stains.
- **4.** Participants must ensure any and all rubbish is disposed of appropriately. No eating will be permitted inside the cemetery. There will be a designated area to eat and drink inside the cottage.
- 5. It is important that you **DO NOT** mark the front of the image with your name or any identifying signature.
- 6. Entries should be clearly labelled on the back with your name, address and telephone number.
- 7. Registration:
 - Pre-Registration is available online before and can be accessed via this link: https://forms.office.com/e/uirBLU4a45
 - Hard-copy registration and stamping of entries will also be required upon arrival. Registration on the day will take place on site and will remain open until 12:30pm.
 - Only entrants that have registered will be able to submit an entry.
- **8.** Only entries bearing the **official stamp** of the **GIBRALTAR HERITAGE TRUST** will be considered. You must have your entry stamped (on the back) **before 12:30pm** on the day.
- 9. Participants may submit a maximum of **TWO** entries.
- **10.** Entries should **NOT** be larger than 76cm x 60cm.
- **11.** The GIBRALTAR HERITAGE TRUST will not be held responsible for any accident, damage to or loss of property that may be incurred by any participant.
- 12. Completed entries should be handed in at the Trust Offices at 13 John Mackintosh Square by 5.00pm on the day. No entries will be accepted after this time.
- **13.** Images of the entered piece **MUST NOT** be posted on any Social Media sites e.g., Facebook, until the entries have been judged and the exhibition of entries is open to the general public at the end of the month.

- **14.** The Trust will not be responsible for the supervision of participants in the children's section. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied at all times.
- **15. SCHOOL ENTRIES:** Schools will be invited to participate in the week leading up to the live event. Only entries bearing the **official stamp** of the **GIBRALTAR HERITAGE TRUST** on the back of the drawings/paintings will be entered in the competition.

- **18.** The **GIBRALTAR HERITAGE TRUST** will keep all winning entries as part of its archive to be used by the Trust as it sees fit.
- 19. Any non-winning entries (this includes highly commended artwork) not collected from the Trust's Office within three months after the date of the competition, will become property of the Trust and will be destroyed or made use of as the Trust sees fit.
- **20.** The announcement of winners and presentation of prizes will be announced at our exhibition opening on **Thursday 29th May in GEMA Gallery**. More information to follow.
