Gibraltar Tiles Products



Fire Over the Rock by James Falkner


Drawing on a wide range of contemporary sources, this book describes the Great Siege of Gibraltar (1779-83), the tenacity and endurance shown by the attackers and defenders alike, and the sheer ingenuity of the siege operations mounted by both sides, make the episode an epic of military history. £19.99

In the Shadow of the British Fortress of Gibraltar: The Phoenix Rises 1783 to 1805, by Dr Richard Garcia.

This is the third and final volume of the trilogy, documenting the social history of Gibraltar in the 18th century, from the capture in August 1704 to the decisive Battle of Trafalgar in October 1805, which was fought close to Gibraltar. The entire work covers just over a century. The spotlight in the past has often been turned on the military, naval and political history of Gibraltar in the 18th century and into the early 19th century but this trilogy offers an insight into the social history of the period.

Defending the Rock by Nicholas Rankin
