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## PAINTING/ DRAWING COMPETITION SATURDAY 7<sup>th</sup> MAY 2022 – CITY HALL

Please make sure you familiarise yourselves with the rules of this year's competition.

## **RULES OF ENTRY**

- 1. All entries must feature an element of the CITY HALL. You will have the choice of painting the exterior or selected areas of the interior (Mayor's Parlour, ground-floor exhibition rooms, etc). The painting(s) must be either a view of, or an element of its exterior/interior features and must be completed between 09:00am 5:00pm on the 7<sup>th</sup> of May.
- 2. Only registered participants will be allowed entry to the City Hall. The building will be closed to the general public, to exclude one supervising adult to any child under the age of 16. (see point 21)
- **3.** Participants will respect cordoned off areas of the building and understand that some areas will have a limited capacity which will be filled on a first come, first served basis.
- **4.** Paintings/Drawings may be carried out using different traditional artistic media. We will not accept any digital entries.
- 5. Participants must supply their own art materials which must be appropriate to the setting and sensitive nature of the building. Materials deemed inappropriate will not be accepted, e.g., spray paint.
- **6.** Participants must respect the venue, its artworks and furniture, and ensure spillage of paint/materials is avoided at all times.
- **7.** Participants agree to cover the cost of any damage caused by themselves or their equipment to any aspect or area of the City Hall.
- **8.** Bathrooms and kitchens are not to be used for the cleaning of paint brushes etc, or for disposal of paint.
- **9.** Food and drink will not be permitted within the ground floor exhibition rooms, and only resealable drink bottles will be allowed in other rooms/areas.
- 10. Participants must ensure any and all rubbish is disposed of appropriately.
- 11. Right of Admission is reserved by the staff of the City Hall.
- **12.** It is important that you **DO NOT** mark the front of the image with your name or any identifying signature.
- 13. Entries should be clearly labelled on the back with your name, address and telephone number.

## 14. Registration:

- Hard-copy registration and **stamping of entries** will also be required upon arrival. Registration on the day will remain open until 12:30pm at the entrance of City Hall.
- Only entrants that have registered will be able to submit an entry.
- **15.** Only entries bearing the **official stamp** of the **GIBRALTAR HERITAGE TRUST** will be considered. You must have your entry stamped **before 12:30pm** on the day.
- 16. Participants may submit a maximum of TWO entries.
- 17. Entries should NOT be larger than 76cm x 60cm.
- 18. The GIBRALTAR HERITAGE TRUST and the custodians of the City Hall will not be held responsible for any accident, damage to or loss of property that may be incurred by any participant.
- 19. Completed entries should be handed in at the Trust Offices at 13 John Mackintosh Square by 5.00pm on the day. No entries will be accepted after this time.
- **20.** Images of the entered piece must not be posted on any Social Media sites e.g., Facebook, until the entries have been judged and the exhibition of entries is open to the general public.
- **21.** The Trust will not be responsible for the supervision of participants in the children's section. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied at all times.

- **25.** Any non-winning entries not collected from the Trust's Office within three months after the date of the competition will become property of the Trust for use as the Trust sees fit.
- **26.** The announcement of winners and presentation of prizes will be communicated and confirmed in due course.
